


COUNCIL MEETING

As some members of the St. Peter community return to in-person worship, please continue to observe our community practices during this pandemic:

We are still following a "masks expected" policy even though the Governor has removed the mask requirement and the CDC recommendations have changed.

Distance seating is still being observed in the sanctuary.

Communion is mostly by household (or, possibly, by pew).

Sanitizing stations are located in the narthex.

Hand shaking, hugs, etc. are still discouraged (a fist or elbow bump is a great replacement).

We have a goal of 100 members of the St. Peter community vaccinated. If you have been recently vaccinated, please contact the church office. As of 5/28, 75 of us have been fully vaccinated.

Now is not the time to pull back from our commitments. Help do your part by continuing to mask, get your vaccine, and stay updated as we continue to amend our policy moving forward.
