P: As we prepare to confess our sins unto God, we remember the great sacrifice God made when He gave His One and Only Son to die to pay for our sins.

On this glorious, holy morning, let us praise and thank God for His goodness! Glory be to You. O Lord God Almighty, for You have overcome death, and granted resurrection life to Your obedient Son, Jesus Christ, that the way to eternal life might be opened to all who will trust and believe in Him.

Prayer of the Day

P: O God, for our redemption you have given Your only-begotten Son to the death of the cross, and by His glorious resurrection You have delivered us from the power of our enemy. Therefore, grant that all our sin may be drowned through daily repentance and that day by day a new man may arise to live before You in righteousness and purity forever; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. C: **Amen.**

The Responsive Scripture Reading

P: The next evening, when the Sabbath ended. Mary Magdalene and Salome and Mary the mother of James went out and purchased embalming spices.

C: **Early the following morning, just at sunrise, they carried them out to the tomb. On the way they were discussing how they could ever roll aside the huge stone from the entrance.**

P: But when they arrived they looked up and saw the stone - a very heavy one -was already moved away and the entrance was open! So they entered the tomb –and there on the right sat a young man clothed in white.

C: **The women were startled, but the angel said, "Don't be so surprised. Aren't you looking for Jesus, the Nazarene who was crucified? He isn't here! He has come back to life!"**

(Luke 24:1-5)

P: Death came into the world because of what one man (Adam) did, and it is because of what this other man (Christ) has done that now there is the resurrection from the dead.

C: **Everyone dies because all of us are related to Adam, being members of his sinful race, and where ever there is sin, death results. But all who are related to Christ will rise again.**
(1 Cor. 15:21 - 22)

P: I am telling you this strange and wonderful secret; we shall not all die, but we shall all be given new bodies!

C: **For our earthly bodies, the ones we have now that can die, must be transformed into heavenly bodies that cannot perish but will live forever.**

P: When this happens, then at last this Scripture will come true - "Death is swallowed up in victory." O death, where then your victory? Where then your sting? For sin - the sting that causes death - will all be gone; and the law, which reveals our sins, will no longer be our judge. How we thank God for all of this! It is He who makes us victorious through Jesus Christ our Lord!

C: So my dear brothers, since future victory is sure, be strong and steady, always abounding in the Lord's work, for you know that nothing you do for the Lord is ever wasted as it would be if there were no resurrection. (1 Cor. 15:51-58)

The Nicene Creed

Easter Prayer for Hope

P: Holy Triune God, on this day of resurrection, we praise Your Name for the sudden surprise of life from death, for "The stone which the builders rejected has become the head of the corner."

C: **"This is the Lord's doing; it is marvelous in our eyes. This is the day the Lord has made; Let us rejoice and be glad in it."** (Ps 118:22-24)

P: On this happy day of resurrection, O Lord God, give to us hope, hope of sin conquered through the cross of Christ and teach us to say:

C: **Therefore, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in our hope of sharing the glory of God.** (Romans 5:1-2)

P: On this blessed day of victory over Satan's power, give to us hope, O Lord God, the hope of eternal life, and teach us to say:

C: **"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! By his great mercy we have been born anew to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, and to an inheritance which is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you."** (1 Peter 1:3-4)

P: When trial and suffering rob us of joy and lead us toward hopelessness, give us Easter hope, O God, that we may:

C: **"Rejoice in our suffering, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts."** (Romans 5:3-5)

P: When we begin to lose our zeal for You, O God, and our spirits grow weary in serving, give us Easter hope, that we may know:

C: **"What is the hope to which He has called you, what are the riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints, and what is the immeasurable greatness of His power in us who believe, according to the working of His great might which He accomplished in Christ when He raised Him from the dead."** (Eph. 1:18-20)

P: Lord Jesus Christ, you are the Conqueror, the Victor, the Giver of life, for you have conquered sin and death.

C: We give You our praise and thanksgiving, risen Lord, forever. Amen!
