#### Welcome

Theme of the Day: We don't build bears, as in a "Build a Bear Workshop"—rather we build gods, just like Israelites in Babylon. That's why Isaiah invites us to "Behold your God" (Isaiah 40:9). And our God is not an inanimate object but a loving and merciful Savior who was crucified for the sins of the world.

## The Holy Gospel, Matthew 1:18-25

P The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew Glory to You, O Lord

Now the birth of Jesus Christ<sup>[a]</sup> took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. <sup>19</sup> And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly. <sup>20</sup> But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. <sup>21</sup> She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." <sup>22</sup> All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet:

<sup>23</sup> "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel"

(which means, God with us). <sup>24</sup> When Joseph woke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him: he took his wife, <sup>25</sup> but knew her not until she had given birth to a son. And he called his name Jesus.
